Metal Art Design & Fabrication
10 months

Students will learn skills such as metal cutting, shaping and fitting, welding, casting, forging and fabrication of metal products. The program also emphasizes the design aspect of metalworking, with students learning how to create unique and functional metal art pieces.



Digital & Precision Technology
9.5 months

Students will learn computer-aided design (CAD) and use computer numerical control (CNC) machines to create precise and complex parts and products. The program also covers topics such as programming, quality control, and materials science.



Welding
14 months

Students will receive hands-on training in a variety of welding methods, including Shielded Metal Arc Welding, Oxy-Acetylene processes, and spot and seam welding, and will practice on a range of materials and projects.
