



Notification on Clerical Recheck and Review of Marking

The Bhutan Council for School Examinations and Assessment (BCSEA) hereby informs students, parents, and schools about the Recheck services available to candidates.

These services are intended to uphold the principles of fairness, transparency, and equity, while also providing appropriate progression opportunities for students.

BCSEA offers the following services:

1. **Clerical Recheck**
2. **Review of Marking**

Detailed eligibility criteria, procedures, timelines, and applicable fees for each service are outlined below.

1. Clerical Recheck

A Clerical Recheck verifies the accuracy of marks awarded and their correct transfer to the result records. It does not involve a review of the content or marking judgement of the answer script.

- **Fee:** Nu. 300 (per paper)
- **Mode:** Application accepted both online and offline.

2. Review of Marking

A Review of Marking involves a detailed re-marking of the entire answer script by a senior marker appointed by BCSEA.

- **Fee:** Nu. 1,500 (to be paid in cash) per paper.
- **Mode:** Application accepted offline only at the BCSEA office.

Further details, including application procedures and deadlines, will be made available on the BCSEA official website and Facebook page. Students and parents are encouraged to review the guidelines carefully to make informed decisions.

NOTE:

- Candidates wishing to apply for clerical recheck or review marking or resit may do so within 7 days after result declaration.
- If the candidate wishes to re-check online, visit G2C online services. For offline, he/she needs to visit BCSEA office.
- If transaction is unsuccessful while applying for recheck through G2C online education services, then the candidates will need to visit BCSEA office Kawajangsa, MoESD, Thimphu.
- No applications will be entertained after the deadline of 15/02/2026 after 5 pm.
