

Registration Guide for the National Scout Jamboree 26-30 May, 2026

The registration for the National Scout Jamboree is between 1-30 April, 2026. The registration must be completed on or before **30 April 2026**. The invitation is extended officially to **ONLY 13 NSOs**, 20 Dzongkhags and 4 Thromdes. No applications will be accepted beyond the invitees.

International participants:

1. The registration for the National Scout Jamboree is extended to 13 National Scout Organizations (NSO), officials from World Organisation of Scout Movement (WOSM), and Asia-Pacific Region (APR), World Scout Bureau. The invited NSOs are:

2. International participants must use this [LINK](#) to register for the National Scout Jamboree.
3. The participants must upload all necessary documents while registering.
4. The organizing team will verify the online registration application within four working days and participants will receive registration confirmation from the team.
5. NSOs can decide either to pay individually or in group and intimate the organising team by responding to the confirmation email.
6. The organising team will accordingly share a link to facilitate the payment.
7. Upon the payment, the team will proceed with the e-visa application process.

National participants:

1. One contingent consisting of four male and four female Scouts from each Dzongkhag and Thromde will be invited for the National Scouts Jamboree. The Dzongkhag/Thromde with more than 3500 Nazhoen Scouts (as of 2025) will be eligible for additional eight members (four male and four female) thereby making the contingent size to 16 members (eight male and eight female).
2. The Dzongkhag Scout Association (DSA) or Thromde Scout Association (TSA) need to facilitate registration of participants as per the slots approved by the Bhutan Scouts Association using the Dzongkhag official email and using this [LINK](#).
3. The participants must submit signed consent forms which can be downloaded from the event webpage [LINK](#).
4. The organizing team will verify the online registration application and Dzongkhag/Thromde will receive a registration confirmation within four working days.
5. Bhutan Scouts Association will NOT accept direct registration from individuals.
