In-Country Training Program on “ToT – Technical Instruction & Andragogy”, for Both Public and Private Training Providers.

The Technical Trainers Training and Resource Centre (TTTRC), Department of Workforce Planning and Skills Development (DWPSD), MoESD, will be conducting ***“ToT- Technical Instruction & Andragogy for the fiscal year 2026-2027”*** to the regular trainers registered with Bhutan Qualifications and Professionals Certification Authority (BQPCA). The training package consist of four modules, each module is for two weeks (96 hour) and one month of teaching practice in between every module at respective institute. This training is conducted as part of partial fulfillment for the trainer to obtain trainer registration certificate and accreditation of courses from TVET Quality Counsel, BQPCA.

Therefore, the Department invites application from interested regular instructor/trainer registered and working with respective institute for minimum of six (06) months. The application for the aforementioned program should be submitted through Google form link provided below. While registering for this training, valid security clearance, appointment letter, and organization/institute nomination letter is required.

The application must be submitted latest by **2 August 2026, 5:00 PM**. The eligible candidates will be selected on first-come-first-served basis applied through the Google form, and they will be trained in two batches if there are many applicants. The first batch is planned to commence from 10 August 2026, and second batch from 31 August 2026. The venue details will be communicated once participants are selected for the program.
